

Structures to Help You in The Generosity Project

Your blog, Weekly Check Reports, Work
Times and Safety Rules

BLOGS:

- EACH PERSON must blog by Friday at 3:40.
- ONE PERSON email a link each week to your Mentor just as a friendly reminder that the blog is ready for them.
- Darrell or Ruff will offer comments each week by Saturday at noon.

BLOG Posts:

- Each person should do a post
- Split up information - if each person writes the same thing it seems repetitive and boring
- MUST HAVE MINIMUM 5 PICS EACH PERSON TOOK per week (aim to take 20 each, and put the best 5 on your post)
- Remember to use a mix of words, pictures, video, etc.
- Ideas for what to write on:
 - ☐ Your accomplishments
 - ☐ Your questions
 - ☐ Your ideas
 - ☐ Your reflection on your successes and struggles
 - ☐ Your plans for next week
 - ☐ Email blog link to Darrell, Mrs. Ruff and Mentor

WEEKLY REPORTS

- Each week your partnership will meet for 10 minutes with McRuff on your scheduled day during 3rd period.
- You MUST have the WEEKLY REPORT (find on Ruff's DP) already filled out.
- Your weekly report is a chance to set new goals, reflect on the last week, problem solve struggles

WORK TIMES

- You will have 3rd period, everyday, to work on your individual project/ reports/ blogs/ etc.
- If you plan to use any school time to do aspects of your project off campus, it should be scheduled between 10 AM and the end of lunch (this will help you miss the least amount of instructional time).
- You should notify McRuff 3 days ahead of any time you will miss their classes.

SAFETY AND LEGAL STUFF

- You can not just leave campus for this project.
- If you leave campus, you must be signed out of school by your parents, AND you must have an ADULT chaperone.
- You must tell McRuff 3 days in advance before you leave campus for this project.
- If you are doing something at a PL Campus school (explorer) with a HTH employee's class, you can have a permission slip instead of be signed out.
- DO NOT TELL YOUR PARENTS YOU MUST LEAVE CAMPUS AND DO THINGS FOR THIS PROJECT. IF THEY FEEL UNCOMFORTABLE, IT MEANS THEY CAN AND SHOULD SAY NO
